

General Repairs in Northeast Harris County

In an effort to keep you informed about the Harris County Flood Control District's continuing improvements in the San Jacinto River watershed, we want to notify you of upcoming projects in your area.

In November 2013, the Flood Control District will start construction on four maintenance projects involving Bens Branch, a major drainage channel in the Kingwood area formally identified as HCFCD Unit G103-33-00, and three of its tributaries. Depending on the specific site, these projects will repair severe to moderate erosion, remove sediment buildup in the channels, replace exposed stormwater and interceptor outfall pipes, and repair concrete slope paving. In some cases, to allow for the repairs, it will be necessary to remove encroachments such as fences and vegetation from Flood Control District right of way. A pedestrian bridge at the end of Park Garden Drive, between Creekwood Middle School and Christ the King Lutheran Church, will be closed for a short period during construction. During this period, trail users may cross the channel at Sandy Forks Drive.

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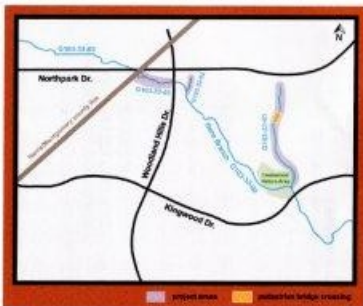
